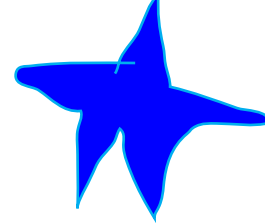
An inspiring class exploring pottery wheel techniques, hand building methods, and major creativity. Learn basic skills on the pottery wheel (we will rotate time during class) and exciting hand building work incorporating the themes of Animals (real and imaginary), and safari art, in sculpture and wheel work, incorporating major creativity. Personal themes and exploration welcome. **If you love to work in clay this class is a must for you.**

Exotic Animal Portraits in Scratchboard... with Kate **Ages 11-16** **Thursdays 6 weeks**

Experience the fun and intricate technique of scratchboard in this wildlife-themed class. Students will learn the fundamentals of depicting light and shadow by first creating drawings on black paper and then diving into the medium of scratchboard, a board that starts black and scratches away to reveal brilliant white lines. They will work from beautiful black-and-white images of various exotic animals to create their drawings and final scratchboard projects. A perfect class for animal-loving, detail-oriented students.

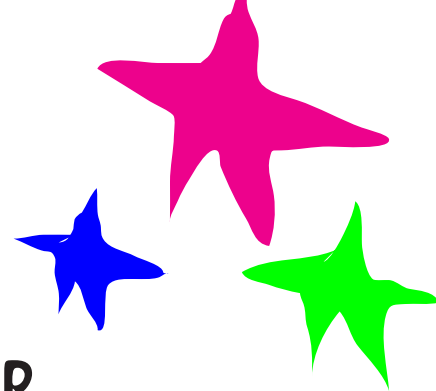
Flora and the Natural World in Scratchboard...with Kate

7-9pm \$180 (supplies & snack included) Feb 14, 28, March 7, 14, 21, 28

Create luminous black-and-white scratchboards inspired by nature. Beginning with drawing exercises that explore the use of light and line work, we will then transition to a final project in scratchboard. A relaxing and methodical technique that mimics the appearance of an engraving, we will scratch away the black surface of the board to reveal the brilliant white surface underneath. Scratchboards will be based on nature photographs provided by Kate. An ideal class for adult students who want to learn a new skill while celebrating the beauty of the natural world.
